

FENERBAHÇE UNIVERSITY DIRECTIVE ON THE ADMISSION OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS TO ASSOCIATE AND UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS

PART ONE Purpose, Scope, Basis, and Definitions

Purpose

ARTICLE 1- (1) The purpose of this directive is to regulate the procedures and principles for the admission of international students to associate and undergraduate programs at Fenerbahçe University.

Scope

ARTICLE 2- (1) This directive covers the procedures and principles for admitting international students to the associate and undergraduate programs at Fenerbahçe University.

Basis

ARTICLE 3- (1) This directive has been prepared based on Articles 14/b/1 and 45/f of the Higher Education Law, published in the Official Gazette dated 06/11/1981 and numbered 17506, as well as the Principles on the Admission of International Students announced by the Council of Higher Education.

Definitions

ARTICLE 4- (1) Definitions of the terms in this Directive are as follows:

- a) Unit: Faculties, colleges, and vocational schools within Fenerbahçe University,
- b) Unit Board: The boards of faculties, colleges, and vocational schools affiliated with Fenerbahçe University,
- c) Unit Manager: Deans in faculties within Fenerbahçe University, principals in colleges and vocational schools.
- d) Unit Board of Directors: The management boards of faculties, colleges, and vocational schools affiliated with Fenerbahçe University,
- e) Department/Program Chair: Chairs of a faculty, school, or vocational school department/program within Fenerbahçe University,
- f) English Preparatory Program: Fenerbahçe University English Preparatory Program,
- g) English Proficiency Exam: Fenerbahçe University English Proficiency Exam,
- h) Board of Trustees: Fenerbahçe University Board of Trustees,
- i) Registrar's Office: Fenerbahçe University Registrar's Office,
- j) ÖSYS: Student Selection and Placement System,

- k) Rector: Fenerbahçe University Rector,
- 1) Senate: Fenerbahçe University Senate,
- m) T.R.: Republic of Turkey,
- n) TÖMER: Turkish Teaching Application and Research Center,
- o) Department of International Relations: Fenerbahçe University Department of International Relations,
- p) University: Fenerbahçe University (FBU),
- q) University Board of Directors: Fenerbahçe University Board of Directors,
- r) YÖK: Higher Education Board.

PART TWO

Principles Regarding Quotas and the Registration Process

Quotas

- **ARTICLE 5-** (1) In the admission of international students, quotas are allocated to the University's associate and undergraduate programs.
- (2) The quotas are determined by the decision of the Senate and the approval of the Board of Trustees and then submitted to the Council of Higher Education. The quotas are finalized upon the approval of the Council of Higher Education.
- (3) The program quotas, language of instruction, evaluation and registration procedures, preparatory classes (if any), and other relevant information are announced on the University's website. Important dates are also indicated in the academic calendar.
- (4) Quotas for programs that are not fully filled by international students can be transferred to other programs in accordance with the procedures determined by the Council of Higher Education.

Application

- **ARTICLE 6-** (1) Candidates may apply for international student status if they are either enrolled in the final year of high school (or an equivalent school) or are high school graduates, and if they meet the qualifications specified in the list in Annex-1.
- (2) The applications of candidates who meet the following conditions will be evaluated.
 - a) Foreign candidates,
 - b) Candidates who were Turkish citizens by birth but have obtained permission from the Ministry of Interior to renounce Turkish citizenship, as well as those whose names are recorded in the Certificate of Renunciation of Turkish Citizenship and who hold a Certificate on the Exercise of Recognized Rights issued under the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901 on behalf of their underage children,
 - c) Except for those who acquired Turkish citizenship by birth, candidates who obtained Turkish citizenship while being foreign nationals or dual nationals in this situation,
 - d) Candidates who have completed the last three years of their high school or equivalent education in a foreign country, excluding the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (KKTC), and who continued their secondary education abroad before 01/02/2013

- (including those who completed the last three years of their high school or equivalent education at Turkish schools established by the Ministry of National Education (MEB) in foreign countries other than the KKTC),
- e) Candidates who began their secondary education abroad after 01/02/2013 and completed their high school or equivalent education in a foreign country, excluding the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (KKTC) (including those who completed it at Turkish schools established by the Ministry of National Education (MEB) in foreign countries other than the KKTC),
- f) Candidates who reside in the KKTC and have completed their high school or equivalent education there and hold a "GCE AL" certificate, as well as those who obtained a "GCE AL" certificate by studying in high schools or equivalent schools in other countries between 2005 and 2010, or who will obtain this certificate by the last day of the final registration period designated for foreign nationals in the academic calendar.
- (3) Candidates with the following qualifications are not eligible to apply for the international student quota:
 - a) Candidates who are Turkish nationals and have completed their high school or equivalent education in Turkey or the KKTC,
 - b) Those who are KKTC nationals and have completed all of their high school or equivalent education in the KKTC but do not hold a "GCE AL" certificate, or candidates who will not obtain this certificate by the last day of the final registration period designated for foreign nationals in the academic calendar,
 - c) Except for those who meet the conditions in subclauses (b), (ç), and (d) of clause (2) of this article, dual-national candidates whose first nationality is the Republic of Turkey by birth,
 - d) Except for those who have completed their high school or equivalent education in the KKTC and hold a "GCE AL" certificate, those who obtained a "GCE AL" certificate by studying in high schools or equivalent schools in other countries between 2005 and 2010, or those who will obtain this certificate by the last day of the final registration period designated for foreign nationals in the academic calendar, dual-national candidates, one of whose nationalities is the KKTC,
 - e) In addition to schools within the embassies in Turkey, Turkish national candidates who have completed their education in foreign high schools or equivalent schools in Turkey, and dual-national candidates whose first nationality is the Republic of Turkey by birth, except as provided in subclause (b) of clause (2) of this article,
 - f) Candidates who have had their Turkish citizenship revoked due to a crime they committed,
 - g) Candidates who have been banned from entering Turkey by the Republic of Turkey.

Exam Types, Minimum Scores, and Required Diplomas for Application

ARTICLE 7- (1) Candidates who meet the national or international exam and diploma types and scores specified in Annex-1 may apply. New exams and conditions may be added by decision of the Senate, and the admission principles may be updated.

- (2) There is no limitation on the validity period of exams (Abitur, International Baccalaureate, GCE, Tawjihi, etc.) recognized as high school completion exams. The validity period of exams (SAT, etc.) recognized as university entrance exams is two years.
- (3) Applicants from countries not listed in Annex-1 are required to have a high school graduation score of at least 50%.

Application Process and Required Documents

- **ARTICLE 8-** (1) Applications are submitted electronically in accordance with the academic calendar and the procedures and principles announced on the University's website. Depending on the nature of the program applied for, the documents required by the University are announced on its website.
- (2) Applications from candidates who do not meet the application requirements or fail to submit the necessary information and documents in full within the specified time limit will not be processed. Once the application process is complete, no changes can be made to the application information or documents.
- (3) Candidates may be required to verify the information and documents submitted during the application process. The University may investigate the accuracy of the submitted information and documents. If a candidate is found to have provided false or irregular information or documents, any admission decision or enrollment in the program will be canceled, and their registration at the University will be considered invalid.
- (4) The documents required for the application are:
 - a) A photocopy of the diploma or temporary graduation certificate obtained from the high school or equivalent school (with a notarized Turkish or English translation if issued in a language other than Turkish or English).
 - b) A transcript or printout of student report cards from high school (with a notarized Turkish or English translation if issued in a language other than Turkish or English).
 - c) A photocopy of the passport page showing the photo and identity information (with a notarized Turkish or English translation if issued in a language other than Turkish or English).
 - d) If required in the announcement, a photocopy of the exam result documents for the exams listed in Annex-1 (with notarized Turkish or English translations).
 - e) Any other documents requested in the announcement.
- (5) If the required information in the application documents is already provided in English, a separate Turkish translation is not required.

Evaluation

ARTICLE 9- (1) Candidates who meet the application requirements will be evaluated by the Department of International Relations. The candidate is notified of the evaluation result electronically, and a "conditional acceptance letter" is sent to those with a positive outcome.

(2) Meeting the application requirements does not guarantee definitive acceptance. The Department of International Relations takes into account the evaluation specified in Annex-1, the grade point average required for the application, the minimum scores required on the

exam(s), and the quotas determined by the University. Based on the preliminary evaluation of the application information and documents, candidates may be interviewed by the relevant unit according to the characteristics of the program, if deemed necessary. Admission to departments that accept students through a special talent exam is conducted according to the procedures and principles established by the relevant program for the exam.

- (3) If the number of applicants is within or below the quota set by the University, all candidates who meet the application requirements and are deemed suitable by the Department of International Relations will be admitted to the University. If the number of applications exceeds the quota, the International Student Admission Commission evaluates the applicants by considering their graduation grade point average and, if applicable, the program-specific assessment and evaluation criteria. Applicants are ranked from the highest to the lowest evaluation score. When candidates have equal evaluation scores, priority is given to the younger applicant.
- (4) An "unconditional enrollment acceptance letter" approved by the Department of International Relations is sent electronically to accepted students who have completed the required prepayment. With this letter, candidates are required to visit the Turkish Embassy in their home country to obtain a "Student Visa". Candidates are responsible for completing the procedures related to the education visa and for covering all costs arising from these procedures.

Registration

ARTICLE 10- (1) Candidates who are entitled to enroll must apply for registration in person or through their legal representatives.

- (2) The documents required for enrollment are as follows:
- a) The original diploma or temporary graduation certificate, and/or a copy approved by a notary, consulate, the issuing school, or the Turkish Embassy in the relevant country.
- b) A copy of the transcript approved by a notary, consulate, or the relevant school.
- c) The original exam result documents or national/international exam certificates, if any, and/or copies approved by a notary, consulate, or the relevant institution.
- d) A photocopy of the visa obtained from the Turkish representative in the candidate's country of residence, or a "residence permit" issued by the Provincial Directorate of Migration Management for candidates residing in Turkey, if applicable. Visa requirements do not apply only to the following candidates:
- i. International students who complete their secondary education in Turkey and wish to pursue associate or undergraduate studies without interruption, as well as children of foreigners holding work and residence permit Turkey. ii. Individuals who acquired Turkish citizenship by birth and later obtained permission from the Council of Ministers to renounce their Turkish citizenship (including those holding a of rights granted regarding under certificate the exercise iii. Individuals who were foreign nationals by birth and later acquired Turkish citizenship, as well as Turkish nationals who completed their high school or equivalent education in a foreign

country other than the KKTC.

- e) A bank receipt showing that the tuition fee has been paid.
- f) A photocopy of the passport page showing the photo and identity information, with the original presented for verification (if issued in a language other than Turkish or English, a notarized Turkish or English translation is required).
- g) Three passport-sized photos.
- ğ) Any other documents specified in the announcement.
- h) The following documents are additionally required from students applying for a residence permit:
- i. Health Insurance,
- ii. Four passport-sized photos,
- iii. A written document showing the address information.
- (3) Documents prepared in a language other than Turkish or English must be accompanied by a notarized or Turkish Embassy-certified translation into Turkish or English. However, if the required information in the documents is already in English, no translation is necessary.
- (4) Candidates who do not complete their final registration within the specified dates will forfeit any rights. They cannot complete the registration process by submitting their documents by mail.
- (5) If it is not possible to submit the original documents during the registration process, or if a document can be obtained at a later date, the process may proceed and a student certificate will be issued, provided that a signed commitment ensures the original document will be submitted. The original documents must be submitted by the specified deadline. Otherwise, the candidates' acceptance and/or registration will be canceled.
- (6) The registration of students who do not pay the tuition fee within the announced period and/or by the dates specified in the submitted payment plan will be canceled.
- (7) If it is determined at any stage that any of the documents required for final registration are forged or falsified, the student's registration will be canceled retroactively to the registration date, and the University will initiate legal proceedings against the student. If the student has left the University, all documents issued to them, including the diploma, will be canceled. Tuition fees paid by these students are non-refundable.
- (8) In the event of a visa refusal, the tuition fee is non-refundable. In exceptional cases, the refund conditions specified in the conditional acceptance letter shall apply.
- (9) Students are required to obtain a residence permit for educational purposes within one month of entering Turkey after completing their university registration. Students holding a residence permit issued outside Istanbul must transfer their files to Istanbul. Students are responsible for covering all costs related to these procedures and for completing them in full accordance with the law.
- (10) The current circulars issued by authorized public institutions regarding international students form the basis for the documents requested by the University concerning visas and residence permits.

Language Proficiency

- **ARTICLE 11-** (1) International students admitted to programs where the language of instruction is Turkish must have at least a "TÖMER B2" level or an equivalent score to begin their studies. The approval of Fenerbahçe University TÖMER is required for students to begin their studies. Students who do not have at least a B2 language level are enrolled in the Turkish language course offered by the University. In this case, students are charged a tuition fee for the Turkish language course. The time spent in the Turkish language course is not counted toward the duration of the academic program.
- (2) A student eligible to enroll in the Turkish-taught programs of the University, if they wish, may attend the English preparatory class for one year. In this case, students are charged a tuition fee for the preparatory class. The one-year period spent in the preparatory class is not counted toward the duration of the academic program. Students who optionally attend the foreign language preparatory class may continue the program they are eligible to enroll in at the end of one year.
- (3) To begin a program taught in a foreign language or with a compulsory foreign language preparatory class, a student must either pass the proficiency exam administered by the Department of Foreign Languages, achieve the score set by the Senate on one of the foreign language exams recognized by the Council of Higher Education/ÖSYM/Senate (provided it is in the relevant language), or successfully complete the foreign language preparatory class. Students' language proficiency level is determined by the placement exam conducted by the Department of Foreign Languages.
- (4) Students who do not pass the foreign language proficiency exam are enrolled in the foreign language preparatory class. A student who passes the proficiency exam held at the end of the first semester in the preparatory class is eligible to continue in the program they were placed in for the second semester.

Tuition Fee

ARTICLE 12- (1) Tuition at Fenerbahçe University is subject to a fee. The tuition fee is determined and annually by the Board of Trustees.

PART THREE Miscellaneous and Final Provisions

Financial Matters

ARTICLE 13- (1) Procedures concerning tuition fees, scholarships, and other financial matters for students admitted from abroad are handled by the Board of Trustees in accordance with the procedures and principles established under the relevant legislation.

Repeal

ARTICLE 14- (1) The "Directive on Admission of International Students to Associate and Undergraduate Programs", adopted at the University Senate meeting on 02/09/2020, has been repealed.

Cases Not Covered by Provisions and Situations of Uncertainty

ARTICLE 15- (1) In cases not covered by this directive, the relevant decisions and regulations of the Council of Higher Education, as well as any decisions made by the Senate, shall be applied.

(2) The Rector, the relevant Vice Rector, the Secretary General, the relevant Deputy Secretary General, the Head of the Department of International Relations, and the unit managers are authorized to resolve any uncertain situations that may arise during the implementation of the provisions of this directive, each within their respective area of responsibility and jurisdiction.

Effective Date

ARTICLE 16- (1) This directive comes into effect upon the decision of the Senate.

Implementation

ARTICLE 17- (1) The provisions of this directive are implemented by the Rector.
